Subject: Direct Student Admission to the Bachelor's Degree Program (Non-TCAS System)
for the Academic Year 2026 At the Akkhararatchakumari Veterinary College,
Doctor of Veterinary Medicine Program (International Program)

1. Admission procedure and required documents

The application can be made online at www.wu.ac.th or <https://entry.wu.ac.th/inter/apply1.asp> from now until **June 7, 2026**. Applicants must follow the guidelines instructed on the webpage. Required documents include:

1. A copy of an academic transcript (covering at least four semesters)
2. A copy of an identification card or passport
3. A portfolio
4. A copy of a certificate of English-proficiency test result
5. Mental health certificate/Psychological evaluation
6. Short essay **"Why I Want to Study Veterinary Medicine at Walailak University"**

After completing the online application, applicants must print out an application fee payment slip of 300 Baht (three hundred baht) and make the payment at any available counter service or mobile banking of Siam Commercial Bank (SCB), Krungthai Bank (KTB), Kasikorn Bank (KBANK) and Bank for Agriculture and Agricultural Cooperatives (BAAC).

2. Number of student intake and applicant's qualifications

2.1 Number of student intake

Doctor of Veterinary Medicine Program (International Program): 50 students (including 10 international students)

2.2 Applicant's qualifications

Applicants must have graduated or currently be enrolled in their final year of high school (Mattayom 6 in the Thai system or its equivalent level) from either international schools in Thailand or abroad.

The applicants who graduated or currently be enrolled in their final year of high school. Applicants must also fulfill the following requirements:

- A cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least four semesters of no less than 3.30
- A cumulative grade average in the English (foreign language) subject of at least four semesters of no less than 3.50
- Graduation from a science–mathematics high school program is required

Applicants who graduated from international schools in Thailand (using English as a medium of instruction) or abroad must satisfy the following stipulations:

- Applicants must submit the academic result of the following subjects: Chemistry, Biology, Physics, and Mathematics
- Achieve a minimum IELTS score of 6.0 or an equivalent score on a recognized English-proficiency test

3. Tuition Fees

The tuition fee for international students is **225,600 Baht per semesters** (two semesters per academic year). The Doctor of Veterinary Medicine Program is a six-year program, totaling six academic years.

Remark: The tuition fee does not include other expenses such as accommodation, personal living costs, or additional fees that may apply.

4. Admission Schedule

5. Other conditions for admission selection

5.1 Incorrect, incomplete, and unqualified application will be considered void, and any paid fees will not be refunded in any cases.

5.2 For Thai applicants, those who wish to decline the admission offer are required to do so through the TCAS website: <https://www.mycas.com>

5.3 If the applicants decline the offer in whichever round, the university will not give a refund back in all cases.

Please note that international applicants (Non-Thai nationals) are not eligible to take the National Veterinary Licensing Examination in Thailand. However, they may pursue professional licensure in their home countries in accordance with local regulations.
